












Get kids into exploring artists with this fun painting activity inspired by the creator of The Hungry Little Caterpillar – Eric Carle.

### What you need:

-  Plain Paper (4 sheets)
-  Poster (ready-mixed) paints
-  Paint pots/cups
-  Small bowl
-  Water
-  Paint Brushes
-  Pencil
-  Scissors
-  Glue

### Step one

First, dilute some paint in paint pots. Make yellow, green and brown mixtures.

### Step two

Paint each colour on plain paper and wait to dry before adding another layer of paint.



### Step three

On the yellow painted paper, trace the outline of your child's hand. Do this six times and cut them out. These will be the petals.



### Step four

Draw out leaf and stem on the green paper and cut them out. Draw outline of the soil and cut that out.

### Step five

Once all the pieces are ready, assemble them by gluing the pieces together on a blank sheet of paper.
