









A great activity to help children understand more about size!

What you need:

-  Paper
-  Printable sunflowers (on next page)
-  Scissors
-  Leaves
-  Glue
-  Pens or paint

Step one

Print out the sunflowers from the next page. Note there are two sets on this page so cut in half to share between two children.

Step two

Ask the children to cut out the sunflowers.

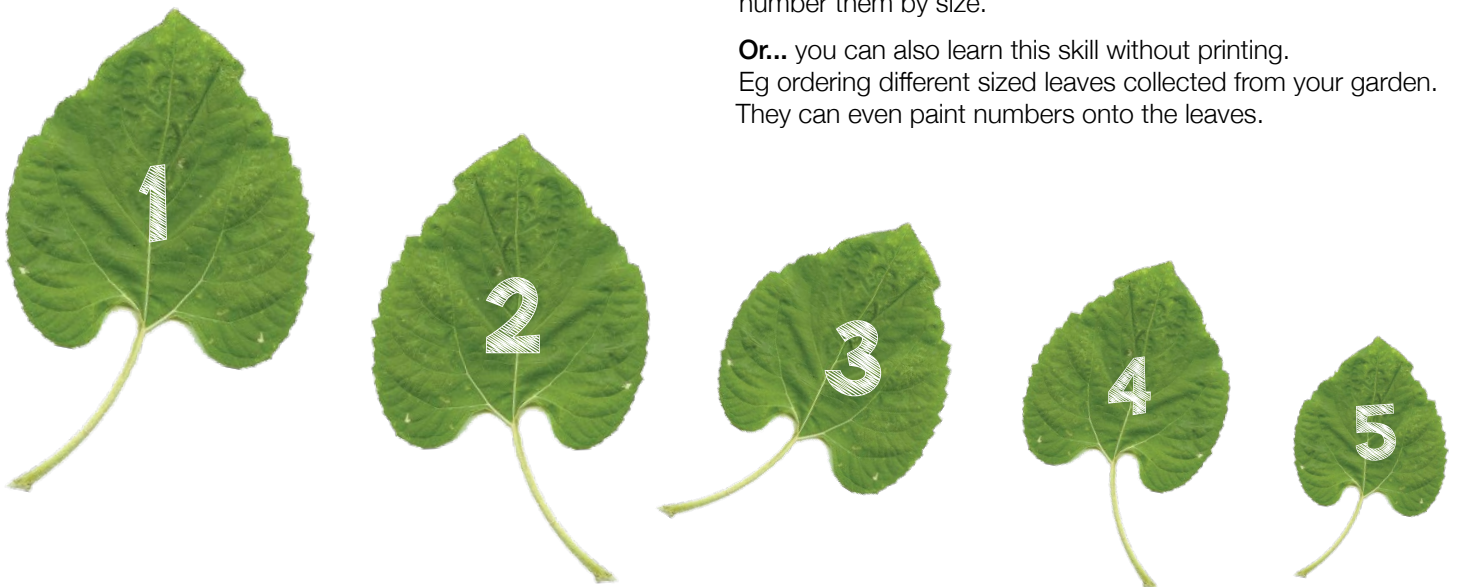
Step three

Then ask them to put them in order from largest to smallest.

Step four

They could then glue them onto a sheet of paper and number them by size.

Or... you can also learn this skill without printing.
Eg ordering different sized leaves collected from your garden.
They can even paint numbers onto the leaves.
