














A super fun learning activity – developing children's counting skills, fine motor skills and hand muscle strength too.

What you need:

-  Printable Numbered Sunflower Centers (on next few pages)
-  White Card Stock
-  Lamination sheets and laminator
-  Scissors
-  Clothes Pegs – 10
-  Yellow Paint (or just use yellow pegs)
-  Paint Brush
-  Jumbo Popsicle Sticks – 10
-  Green Paint
-  Glue



Step one

Print the Numbered Sunflower Centers onto white card.

Step two

Laminate the cards to make them more durable.

Step three

Cut out the circles.

Step four

Paint the clothes pegs with the yellow paint.
Or just use yellow pegs.

Step five

Paint the jumbo popsicle sticks with the green paint.

Step six

After the paint dries, glue the popsicle sticks on the back of the sunflower centers.

How to play

- Pick a sunflower.
- Identify the number.
- Count that number of clothes pegs.
- Peg the clothes pegs onto the center of the sunflower.
- Practice counting backwards by removing one clothes peg or flower petal at a time.
