







**Make your own DIY watering can in just a matter of minutes.
It's not only easy but it's GREEN.**

What you need:

-  Clean plastic milk jug of any size
-  Needle – TIP: A large safety pin works well, but if you'd like to have a finer spray, choose a smaller needle.
-  Matches or lighter – TIP: A lighter may work better, since you have to reheat the needle often. Please note: The heating of the needle and poking through the lid should be done by an adult.
-  Paints for decorating



Step one

Remove the plastic cap from the bottle. Pick up your needle or safety pin, and heat the tip for a few seconds.

Step two

Pierce the milk bottle lid with the hot needle. You may have to reheat the needle after each puncture or two. Make a few holes to start; you can always go back and add more holes if you feel the spray is too fine.

Step three

Fill the milk jug with water, screw the lid back on, and give it a try!

Step four

If you are feeling creative you can decorate the milk bottle.
