








Daltons Sunflowers in kindergartens



Popsicle Stick Sunflowers Art Activity

What you need:

-  Popsicle sticks
-  Hot glue and glue gun
-  Cardboard cereal box
-  Scissors
-  Pencil
-  Acrylic paints
-  Paint brushes

Step one

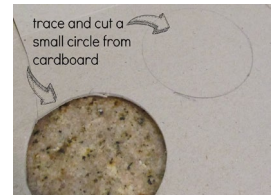
Trace and cut a small circle from a cereal box.

Step two

Cut several popsicle sticks in half.

Step three

Using your hot glue and hot glue gun, arrange the popsicle sticks around the cardboard circle and affix in place with the hot glue.



Step four

Continue until the sticks have made one complete circle around the circle.

Step five

Repeat with an additional circle of popsicle sticks so you end up with the sunflower shape as shown below. Glue one full stick on for the stem.

Step six

Paint the flowers using paint colours of your choice.

Step seven

Once the flowers are dry you can "plant" them in a container with brown paper bags or tissue for soil as shown below. Or add them to your garden.
