









**This fun activity will get your kindy kids excited about telling time!**

It can be confusing to separate the hour and minute hand, then convert the numbers to get the time on an analog clock – this sunflower clock will make telling time easier.

### What you need:

-  Card stock paper
-  Scissors
-  Wall Clock
-  Tape / light adhesive
-  Paint
-  Petal & stem templates

### Step one

Print off the template for the number petals onto yellow card stock and then cut them out. Use light adhesive to stick the number petals around the clock.

### Step two

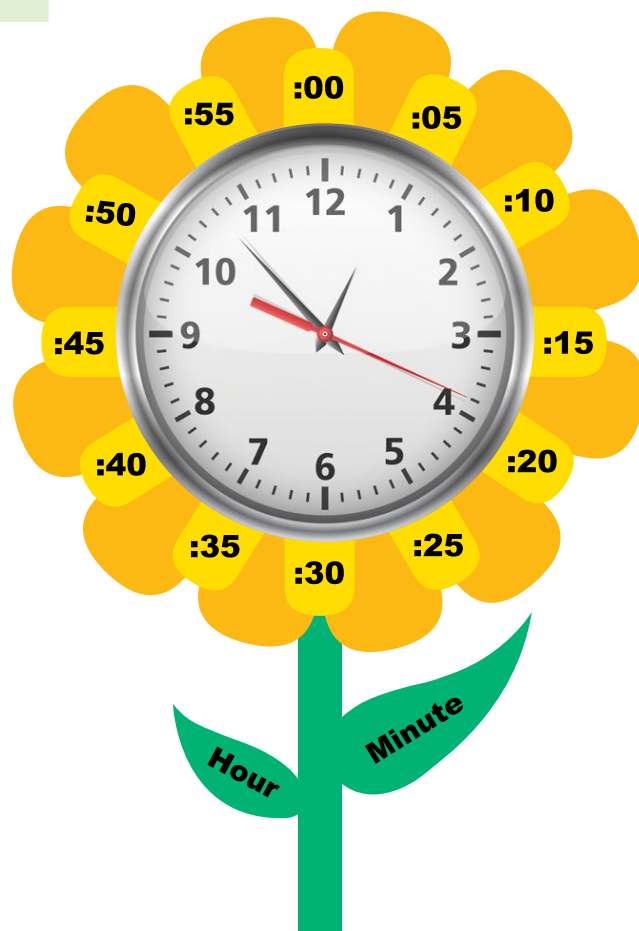
Print the larger petals templates out onto white card stock, then cut out. Get the kids to paint the larger petals with paint. Once those have dried tape them to the back of the clock.

### Step three

Print the stem and leaves template onto green card stock, cut out, adhere together and tape to back of the clock. You are now ready to hang your sunflower clock on the wall.

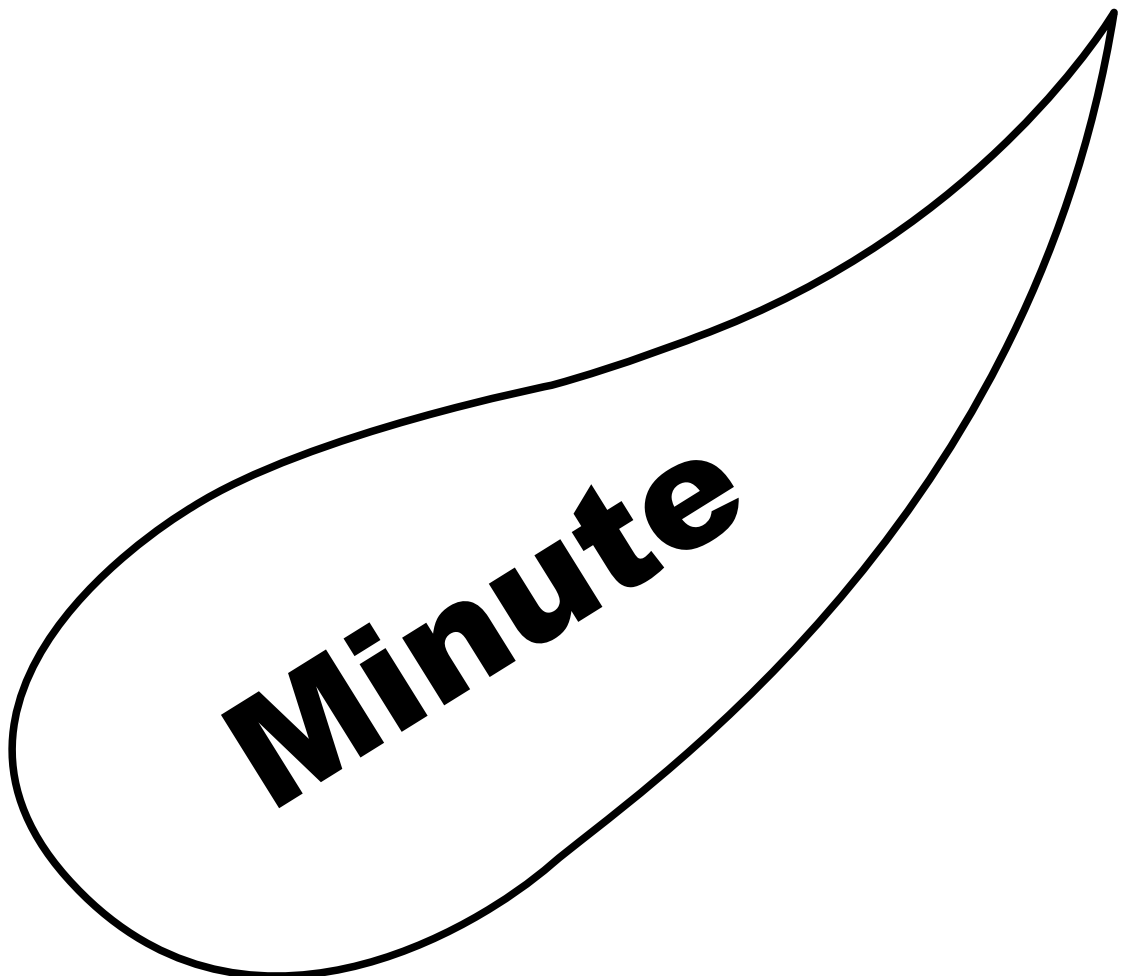
