










Children will love to stamp and create their own sunflowers!

### What you need:

-  Toilet paper roll
-  Yellow and green paint
-  Paint brush
-  Scissors
-  Sheet of paper
-  Glue
-  Sunflower seeds

### Step one

Cut equal length slits along one side of the toilet paper roll.  
Fold slits back to create a sunflower petals.

### Step two

Brush on yellow paint on the sunflower petals.

### Step three

Now children can stamp sunflowers on paper.

### Step four

Once paint is dry, glue on sunflower seeds in the middle of the sunflower.

### Step five

Draw stems on to create a full bloom sunflower.
