



A great activity for young children that develops fine and gross motor skills.

What you need:



Contact paper i.e. sticky back plastic



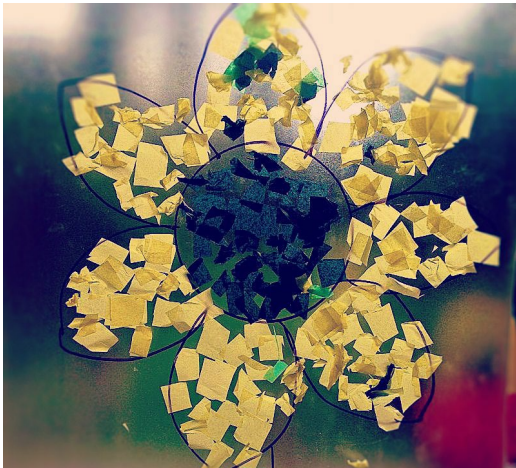
Cellotape



Tissue paper (brown, yellow, green)



Black marker pen



Step one

Cut out a large rectangle of the contact paper. Peel off the back.

Step two

Stick at a low height on a window or glass door with sticky side up.

Step three

Draw an outline of a sunflower.

Step four

Cut tissue paper into small squares or allow your child to tear up small pieces.

Step five

Allow your child to stick the tissue onto the sunflower until they're done with all the pieces.
